## Use of the "self-adjusting chain wheel"

Dear Management,
Dear Patent Department,

Today, I will allow myself to indicate once again that, unfortunately, I am not in a position to send an offer for delivery of the "self-adjusting chain wheel" to those interested.

The "self-adjusting chain wheel" is NOT marketed by me, as I would like to sell the corresponding patent, EP 2594824, which is protected by property rights in the following ten countries

Germany, Austria, Switzerland, France, United Kingdom, Italy, Spain, Romania, Czech Republic and Poland.

The reference object which, on the basis of the previous patent, had been installed at Ensdorf power plant in 2001, is still available there together with one and the same chain by company Ketten Wulf and has been working flawlessly until the end of 2017, without needing to be replaced even once.



Due to the decommissioning of the power, unfortunately, it is no longer possible to determine how many more years this "self-adjusting chain wheel" together with the original chain by Ketten Wulf would have been working under normal circumstances.

Do you know another instance where one and the same chain would not have needed to be replaced over such a long period of more than 16 years? I do not think so.

The fact that the combination of "the self-adjusting chain wheel and a chain by Ketten Wulf" has been in use over such a long period without a single fault should, in my opinion, be incentive enough for all operators to use this combination with a view to reducing costs.

It should be in the interest of the chain industry and the plant manufacturers to achieve this aim and to contribute towards maintaining Europe as a location.
